Play a slightly changed version of the children's game 'I went to market and...', as if you were living in Nazi Germany:

To make the game harder, play the game as if you were one of the following:

'I was a ... and I ...'

- a National Party member
- a German factory worker
- a German teenage boy
- a German teenage girl
- a German woman
- a German Jew
- an Edelweiss Pirate
- a member of the Beck group
- a German civilian during the Second World War

Or you could make it harder still by changing the opening sentence to one of the following:

'I was a ... and I enjoyed...' 'I was a ... and I suffered...'

- 'I was a ... and I experienced...'
- 'I was a ... and I thought...'
